Year End 2019

This past year, your faithful support has helped the Lighthouse Rescue Mission create new opportunities for people to work and live in Tulare! We are busy building a community of hope, job opportunities and housing for those stuck in the devastating existence of homelessness.

YOU HELP PROVIDE HOPE!

Here are some of the great things happening:

- We hired an experienced CEO. Dave Clevenger brings experience and vision to the Lighthouse.
- We added a room & board facility to the Lighthouse for women. This is stable, supported housing with a low fee to support homeless women. We have had 3 women and 6 children in stable residence since August.
- We expanded shelter to include a volunteerism component. Now the women who want to stay beyond 5 days have the option to have a hopeful, safe and dignified place to go during the day on Cross Street.
- We secured new buildings and revamped thrift. A men's home on "G" street, a work site at the yellow building on Cross St, and a renewed thrift store. All meant to create new hopeful opportunities in 2020 for our clients and volunteers.
- But most of all, we have begun to tell the story of homelessness to our community. Each person experiencing homelessness suffers 2 things: 1) overwhelming emotional pain/stress & 2) devastating physical loss. To overcome it, they need Jesus and good neighbors. We are sharing both to people stuck in homelessness.
- 2020 will be a great year as we share our faith and open doors for our neighbors. STAY TUNED AND THANK YOU!
